

The genus *Zergabriella*, a review

On the basis of well-preserved specimens, Dragastan (1999) emended the diagnosis of the genus *Zergabriella* Granier (1989), introduced a new species ascribed to the same genus, and finally described two new taxa, a genus and its type-species, namely *Pseudosalpingoporella cernavodensis* n.gen. n. sp. As demonstrated by tri-dimensional reconstructions, all specimens belong to the same species *Zergabriella embergeri* and the generic and specific emendations are null and void.
